MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 10

SUBJECT: Guidelines for Amateur Radio Stations

Pursuant to Letter of Instruction No. 13-A of the President of the Philippines dated September 29, 1972, effective immediately, the following guidelines governing the operation of amateur radio stations are hereby announced:

1. The operation of mobile amateur radio stations on all amateur bands is suspended until further orders.
2. The operation of fixed amateur radio stations in the two-meter band (144 – 148 MHz) is suspended until further orders.
3. Operation in the other amateur bands by fixed amateur radio stations is allowed subject to the following limitations and prohibitions:
 - a. Transmissions shall be limited to messages which are purely about amateur radio matters or as prescribed in Department Order No. 13, series of 1971. No political subject shall be discussed over the air;
 - b. Transmissions of commercial messages and coded messages, except international “Q” signals, are prohibited; and
 - c. Use of profane and indecent language in any type of transmission is prohibited.

Any amateur radio station found violating this Circular shall be subject to the penal provisions of Act 3846, as amended.
