**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NO. 14**

**SUBJECT: Guidelines for Use of Land Base and Mobile Radio Stations**

Effectively immediately, all radio operating agencies falling under the following categories are allowed to operate base and land mobile radio stations if their stations have previously licensed:

1. Hospitals and ambulance
2. Security agencies with clearance from the Philippine Constabulary.
3. Logging, mining and oil exploration companies.
4. Oil companies and oil refineries including their delivery vehicles
5. Commercial scale plantations, such as pineapples, bananas, sugar cane, coconuts, etc.
6. Commercial scale livestock and cattle raising companies.
7. Transportation companies.
8. Contractors and construction companies or firms
9. Banks and similar banking institutions.

Applications for licenses for base and land mobile radio stations may be filed with the Radio Control Office if accompanied with construction permits duly approved by the Secretary. However, hand-held radio transceivers may be licensed if application is only for additional unit(s) to existing licensed stations on a frequency sharing basis.
