MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

NO. 8

SUBJECT: Sale of Multichannel Master Oscillator Controlled and Frequency Synthesizer Types of Transmitters and/or Transceivers

Pursuant to Letter of Instruction No. 13-A of the President of the Philippines dated September 29, 1972, the following guidelines regarding the sale of multichannel master oscillator controlled and frequency synthesizer type of transmitters and transceivers are hereby announced:

1. Sale of multichannel master oscillator controlled and frequency synthesizer types of radio transmitters and/or transceivers should be limited to the Armed Forces of the Philippines and the amateur service and with prior approval of the Radio Control Office;
2. The types of radio transmitter and transceiver mentioned above, when sold to any amateur radio licensee, will only be provided with the channels where said license is authorized to operate. All the unassigned channels will be disabled and sealed prior to sale and subject to inspection by the Radio Control Office; and
3. Any such transactions should be reflected in the monthly report of sales to be submitted by the concerned dealer/manufacturer to the Radio Control Office.

All authorized radio dealers/manufacturers engaged in the sale of the above-mentioned types of transmitters and/or transceivers are enjoined to comply strictly with this Circular. Failure to do so will subject those concerned to the provisions of Act 3846, as amended, and the revocation of their respective permits.
