MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

NO. 9

SUBJECT: **Guidelines for Usage of Frequency/Frequencies by Any Government-Owned Radio Station except those of the Armed Forces**

To effect maximum regulation and control of radio communications and in order to effect optimum and orderly utilization of the radio frequency spectrum as directed in Letter of Instruction No. 13-A of the President of the Philippines dated September 29, 1972, the following guidelines for usage of any frequency by government-owned radio stations are hereby announced:

1. No government agency or instrumentality, national or local, should use any portion of the radio frequency spectrum without first obtaining from the Radio Control Office or its Field Offices at Cebu City, Davao City and Tolosa, Leyte, the necessary authorization for such usage;
2. The authorization to be issued by the Radio control Office will specify the necessary terms and conditions, to include:
 - a. Frequency or frequencies to be used
 - b. Location of the station
 - c. Maximum power output allowable
 - d. Type of emission
 - e. Bandwidth
 - f. Directivity of maximum radiation
 - g. Time of operation
 - h. Points of communication
 - i. Description of equipment
 - j. Call sign to be used
3. All government-owned radio stations shall be operated in accordance with the terms and conditions of their respective authorizations and in conformity with existing local and International Radio Rules and Regulations;
4. The operation of government-owned stations will be handled only by duly licensed radio operators.

Failure to comply with this Circular will result in the revocation of the authorization issued to such government-owned stations.
