

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

NO. 35

SUBJECT : Guidelines for the Granting of Clearance for the Release of Imported Transceivers/Transmitters and Components Thereof either at MIA or Customs Port Zone.

1. Effective this date, the following documents are required for the granting of clearance by this Office for the release of imported radio transceivers/transmitters, radio crystals, and radio kits either at MIA or Customs Port Zone:

For AUTHORIZED DEALERS:

1. Airway Bill for MIA or AIRPORTS, and Shipping Documents for Customs Port Zone.
2. Copy of valid Dealer's Permit.
3. Certification from the RCO that they are regularly Rendering monthly reports. In lieu of such certification, a copy of their last up-to-date report filed with RCO showing STAMPED of receipt.

For INDIVIDUAL IMPORTERS:

1. Permit to Purchase.
2. Permit to Possess may be acceptable under the following Conditions:
 - a. On the spot purchases made by returning Residents; and
 - b. Purchases made prior to Martial Law and Equipment held at the Customs for whatever Reasons.

For IMPORTATION OF RADIO TRANSMITTER OR TRANSCEIVER SETS OR KITS:

1. Valid Manufacturer's Permit or Permit to Construct a Transmitter or Transceiver.

For IMPORTATION OF LOW-POWER CITIZENS BAND SETS OF 100 MILLIWATTS OR LESS:

1. Permit to Purchase, including the Permit to Operate.

For IMPORTATION OF CRYSTALS:

1. Permit to Purchase as required under Memorandum Circular Nos. 7 & 18.

For IMPORTATION OF RADIO SETS & CRYSTALS BY THE MILITARY:

1. Clearance or authorization from Chief, Communications-Electronics, GHQ, AFP.
2. The duly designated Radio Inspectors of this Office in the MIA or Customs Port Zone are hereby directed to enforce strictly the provisions of this Memorandum Circular.
