

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR  
NO. 41**

**SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF OPERATION OF RADIO STATIONS FOR END-  
USERS.**

In line with the policy of the Government to integrate telecommunications in this country, the operation of radio stations for end-users will have to be phased out. However, in order to provide a period of orderly transition, the operation of said radio stations may be extended up to June 30, 1974.

All franchise holders desiring to extend the operation of existing radio stations for their end-users shall file the necessary applications to the Radio Control Office. The applications for those stations whose licenses are expiring on December 31, 1973 must be filed not later than January 25, 1974, while those stations whose licenses will expire beyond that date but before June 30, 1974 must be filed 30 days before the expiration date of the respective licenses.

The applications to be filed shall be accompanied by a letter stating the reasons/justifications for the requested extension of the operation of subject radio stations, and supported by the clearances and information sheets required by Memorandum Circular No. 39 of this Office dated November 30, 1973. Applicants who may not be ready to submit the abovementioned clearances may first submit the applications together with the letter, original licenses of subject stations and the duly accomplished Information Sheets, provided that the clearances are submitted within 30 days from the date of filing the said applications.

Subsequent application for modification of any radio station license to be extended under this Circular will not be considered by this Office.

It is advised that affected end-users shall immediately initiate arrangements to avail of the existing services and facilities of the domestic public carriers under such terms and conditions mutually agreeable to both of them.

This Circular shall take effect immediately and supersedes any existing circular, order, or instruction, or part thereof which is inconsistent herewith.
