

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NO. 75-01**

**SUBJECT: REQUIRING APPLICANTS FOR PERMIT TO POSSESS RADIO TRANSMITTERS/TRANSCEIVERS TO SUBMIT CERTAIN PAPERS TO SUPPORT THEIR APPLICATIONS.**

Pursuant to the Radio Control Law, Act No. 3846, as amended, and Presidential Letter of Instruction No. 13-A dated September 29, 1972, applicants for permits to possess radio transmitters/transceivers are hereby required to submit to this Bureau the following papers to support their applications;

1. Any Equipment History Statement showing the source(s) of the equipment.
2. A copy of the receipt of payment of customs duties, or if not paid, a clearance therefor from the Bureau of Customs if equipment came from abroad.

Non-compliance of the foregoing requirements will constrain this Bureau to disapprove any applications for a Permit to Possess a radio transmitter/transceiver, without prejudice to taking such further appropriate action against the person concerned for unauthorized possession of a radio transmitter/transceiver in violation of existing radio laws and regulations.

This Circular takes effect on March 01, 1975 and it supersedes any circular, order or instruction or part thereof which is inconsistent herewith.
