

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR  
NO. 76-06**

**SUBJECT: GUIDELINES IN THE CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS  
FOR MOBILE RADIO STATIONS ON BOARD MOTOR  
VEHICLES AND OTHE REQUIREMENTS IN THE OPERATIONS  
THEREOF.**

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Henceforth, priority in the consideration of applications for mobile radio stations shall be on utility vehicles used in carrying out the activities of industrial, commercial, and other business concern and essential service.

Licensing of mobile radio stations to be installed in cars for personal use is restricted. Applications will be considered on a case to case basis.

All utility vehicles of firms and other business concern with installed mobile radio stations shall bear at their both sides the logo or business/firm name, the lettering of which shall be not less than 1.25 in size, for ready identification. Likewise, the posting of call-sign stickers at the rear windshields of the vehicles, which do not have rear windshields, the call-sign stickers must be posted at a conspicuous place on both sides of the vehicle. If no call-sign sticker is available, the call sign must be painted at the sides of the vehicle as herein specified, the letters/number of which shall be not less than 2" in size.

All owners of existing mobile radio stations on board motor vehicles are hereby given ninety (90) days from the date hereof to comply with the requirements of this Circular not covered by Memorandum Circular No. 75-3 as herein above mentioned.

Non-compliance of this Circular may result in the revocation or cancellation of existing licenses.

This circular shall take effect immediately, and the same supersedes any order, circular or instruction or part thereof, which is inconsistent herewith.
