

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 76-07

**SUBJECT: PRESCRIBING THE REGISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT
OWNED AND OPERATED RADIO STATIONS AND OTHER
REQUIREMENTS.**

In order to effect a better coordination in the use and operation of government radio stations and for purposes of sound planning of our national telecommunications system, the following guidelines are hereby prescribed to be observed by all government agencies currently operating radio stations or those which may hereafter be authorized to operate such stations:

1. All government agencies currently operating radio stations must register their stations with this Bureau within ninety (90) days from the date of this Circular, and shall indicate in their registration the exact address and location of their individual stations and the kind /class and operating frequencies of such stations. Thereafter, they shall register their stations every two (2) years from the date of their last registration with this Bureau , giving the same information as herein mentioned to include new additional stations, if any. Any agency of the Government which may hereafter be authorized to establish and operate radio stations shall also comply with said requirement by registering all its stations with this Bureau every two (2) years from and after the date of the frequency authorization that may be issued, indicating the same information as indicated herein.
2. No government agency with an existing frequency authorization or which may hereafter be granted such frequency authorization shall construct, establish or operate additional radio stations outside of those originally authorized without first securing a permit form this Bureau. Likewise, any such agency intending to establish and operate radio stations shall first make technical consultation with this Bureau especially in pre-determining the availability and suitability of needed frequency and secure a permit to purchase radio communications equipment.
3. All government agencies now operating or which may hereafter be authorized to operate radio stations shall see to it that the operation of their stations are or shall be handled by duly licensed radio operators as prescribed in Memorandum Circular No.9 dated October 12, 1972.

Non-compliance of any of the requirements prescribed herein will result in the withdrawal, cancellation or revocation by this Bureau of the frequency authorization of the government agency concerned.



The AFP and the NISA are exempted from the application of this Circular as regards their station being used in carrying out their respective missions.

This Circular shall take effect immediately, and it supersedes any order, circular, or instruction or part thereof, which is inconsistent herewith.
