

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 09-77

SUBJECT : Providing Guidelines to Simplify Filing and Processing of Applications for Permits to Construct and Operate Certain Classes of Radio Stations.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Radio Control Law, Act No. 3846, as amended, and Presidential Letter of Instruction No. 13-A dated September 29, 1972, and in order to simplify the filing and processing of applications for permits to construct new radio stations, the following guidelines are hereby prescribed:

1. An applicant for permit to construct new radio station except stations in the maritime and aeronautical mobile services, shall submit an application in letter form specifying the kind of station(s) or communication system proposed to be constructed/installed, together with statement regarding the nature of the business of the applicant and a short statement justifying the setting up of the proposed station(s) /communication system.
2. A list of officers and members of the Board of Directors duly certified by the Secretary of the Board shall also be submitted specifying the position, address and citizenship of each.
3. A regular application together with all other requirements needed for each type of radio service shall be submitted only after the application in form letter mentioned in item 1 above has been duly approved.

This Circular shall take effect immediately and it modifies any other order, memorandum or instruction or part thereof which is inconsistent herewith.
