

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NO. 11-79**

**SUBJECT: SUSPENDING ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR NEW  
RADIO STATIONS WITHIN THE HF BAND**

---

It was observed that there has been a large number of applications being filed for new radio stations within the HF Band. In Order that this Bureau could consider as many applications as possible, it is necessary to make a further study of its present policy to maximize the use of said band.

Pending the formulation of updated policy guidance therefor, including frequency listings and a review of all related records, the acceptance of applications for new radio stations within the HF Band is hereby suspended. However, applications filed by government agencies/instrumentalities may be accepted and processed according to the existing policies of this Bureau.

This Circular takes effect June 1, 1979 and shall remain in force until superseded or amended.
