

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NO. 5-3-82**

**SUBJECT: Creating an Interim Citizens Band Radio Advisory Council**

In accordance with Ministry Circular No. 79-003, of the Ministry of Transportation and Communications (MOTC), series of 1979, as implemented by Memorandum Circular No. 02-11-79 of the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC), series of 1979, the Citizens Band (CB) Radio Service was opened to various organizations for civic action purposes. In order to effectively regulate, control and supervise the use thereof by civic organizations, there is hereby created an interim Citizens Band Radio Advisor Council which shall serve as an advisory and/or consultative body to assist the NTC in the study and formulation of a unified policy guidelines and in providing a clear-cut direction affecting the B Radio Service in this country. The Council, in particular, shall:

1. Advise the Commissioner in the adoption of policies and in the promulgation of necessary measures to carry out such policies and objectives affecting the CB Radio Service in the country.
2. Monitor organizational activities of civic organizations, using the Service and recommend measures that may be necessary to bring about a closer cooperation and coordination in their operation and to promote harmonious relationship among themselves.
3. Attend to such matters as are desirable in its advisory and/or consultative capacity or as may be directed by the Commissioner.

The Council shall be composed of a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and five members, all of whom shall be duly designated by the Commissioner. The Commissioner may change the composition or membership of the Council whenever he deems it proper and necessary to be designated also by the Commissioner which shall act as recorder of the proceedings of the Council in its conferences or meeting and to attend to its secretarial/staff activities.

The Council shall meet once in every two months or as often as may be necessary, or when directed by the Commissioner.

All civic organizations authorized to use the CB Radio Service and duly accredited by the NTC, are hereby called upon to closely coordinate their organizational activities with the Council and to cooperate in the implementation of this Circular.

This Circular shall take effect March 15, 1982 and it supersedes or amends any circular, order or instruction or part thereof issued earlier by this Commission which is inconsistent herewith.
