

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 10-06-87

**SUBJECT: ALLOCATION OF UHF FREQUENCIES FOR THE EXCLUSIVE
USE OF THE NATIONAL POLICE.**

Recognizing the vital role of the National Police in our community and nation as a whole and considering further the importance of communication in their operations, the following UHF bands are hereby allocated for the exclusive use of the National Police;

- A. For Simplex Operation: 410 – 410.95 Mhz.
- B. For Duplex Operation: TX: 408.125 – 409.00 Mhz.
RX: 413.125 – 414.00 Mhz.

For Frequency Management purposes, the National Police shall periodically submit to the Frequency Management, NTC a list of all frequency assignments made by them and their network technical specifications (to include frequency/ies, locations of stations, bandwidth, emission, power, and area/s of coverage of each station).

All existing users within the above frequency bands shall be allowed to continue their operation until after the lifetime of the equipment's which are currently in use.

This Circular shall take effect immediately upon approval.
