

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 87-16-6

**SUBJECT: TABLE OF FREQUENCY SUB-ALLOCATION IN THE ULTRA
HIGH FREQUENCY (UHF) BAND (300-3000 MHz).**

Pursuant to law and as a signatory to the International Telecommunications Convention providing for the orderly and rational use of the radio frequency spectrum, there is hereby se a TABLE OF FREQUENCY SUB-ALLOCATION IN THE UHF BAND (300-3000 MHz) to be followed in the assignment of frequencies to qualified applicants. As a consequence hereof, the earlier limitation on the assignment of frequencies in the UHF band for the sole use of common carriers is hereby LIFTED.

In the implementation of the new Table, the National Telecommunications Commission shall require radio stations to establish and operate in strict adherence to the standards of good engineering practice and in such a manner as not to cause harmful interference with other existing stations.

The NTC shall update or upgrade the Table, whenever necessary, to allow the application of the latest technical advances in telecommunications and for an efficient, economic and optimize use of frequencies in the interest of public welfare, security and safety.

Any Ministry or Department Circular or Orders in pursuance thereto, in conflict with this Circular, is hereby deemed revoked, revised or amended.

This Circular takes effect immediately.
