

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 11-23-88**

**SUBJECT: AMENDING MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 08-09-83 DATED
16 SEPTEMBER 1983. PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL
REGULATIONS GOVERNING SETTLEMENT OF RADIO
ACCOUNTS**

Pursuant to the provision of Act No. 3846, as amended, and Memorandum Circular No. 04-02-82, concerning settlement of maritime radio accounts and to enable the Commission regulate and supervise effectively the operation and handling of maritime accounts in the maritime mobile service, the following regulations amending certain provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 08-09-83 are hereby promulgated;

1. The operational and accounting provisions for Maritime Mobile Service as recommended by CCITT in 1984, Section 9-Divisions A to E (Rec E.200/F.110) and J to M (Rec D.90/F.111), are hereby adopted and made part of this Circular.
2. All shipping companies, particularly those engaged in the international trade, shall subscribe for the services of Sycip, Gorres, Velayo and Company (SGVD & Co.) only for the settlement of maritime radio accounts.
3. The Commission shall refuse to accept any applications for new or renewal station license/permit from any ship radio station of vessel used or to be used in the international trade if the licensee/shipping company has no agreement entered into with the SGV & Co. or has an unpaid maritime radio accounts for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days or more.
4. SGV & Co. shall submit to this Commission periodic reports on delinquent accounts of shipping companies in its roster within the first week of the month following every quarter of the year, taking into consideration the pertinent operating and accounting procedures involved.
5. The Commission shall, upon receipt of reports on delinquent accounts from the RPOA, serve notice to the shipping companies concerned and take possible steps to ensure settlement of accounts from the licensee.
6. This Circular supercedes pertinent provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 08-09-83 where any of its provisions in whole or in part are in conflict with the foregoing provisions.
7. Strict compliance with this Circular by all entities concerned is hereby enjoined.
8. This Circular shall take effect immediately.
