

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 14-10-02**

**SUBJECT: FREQUENCY ALLOCATION FOR PUBLIC RADIO NETWORK
SERVICE (PRNS)**

Whereas, pursuant to Rule 600 of MC 08-09-95, Implementing Rules and Regulations on RA 7925, the radio spectrum allocation and assignment shall be subject to review in the interest of public service and in order to keep pace with the development in the wireless technology with the end in view of insuring a wider access to the limited radio spectrum and the use of cost effective technology;

Whereas, the Commission is mandated to promote and sustain a healthy competitive telecommunications environment;

Whereas, pursuant to RA 7925, the growth and development of telecommunications networks and services shall be pursued;

Whereas, under the same Act, the Government shall allocate the spectrum to service providers to meet public demand for telecommunications services;

The National Telecommunications Commission, pursuant to RA 7925, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, EO 546 series of 1979 and Act No. 3846, as amended, hereby reallocates the frequency band 410-430 MHz for Public Radio Network Service (PRNS) subject to:

Existing licenses affected by this Memorandum Circular shall be transferred to other appropriate bands, consistent with the terms and conditions of its license and Rule 603 of Memorandum Circular 03-03-96

This Circular shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation and Three (3) copies furnished the UP Law Center.
